

Izvešće o 2nd Croatian Health Economics Workshop

Od 21. do 22. svibnja 2024. u Dubrovniku, Hrvatska, održana je 2. hrvatska zdravstvena ekonomska radionica (2nd Croatian Health Economics Workshop) u organizaciji Ekonomskog fakulteta Sveučilišta u Rijeci i Croatian Health Economics Association. Konferencija je održana u Inter-University Center-IUC u Dubrovniku, Hrvatska.

Radionica je nastavila prošlogodišnji interaktivni format sa svakim prihvaćenim radom koji je dobio temeljitu raspravu. Sesije su uključivale kratke prezentacije (15 min.), rasprave dodijeljenih stručnjaka (15 min.) i otvoreno sudjelovanje publike, obzirom da ovaj format za cilj ima stvaranje poticajnoga okruženje za znanstvenu razmjenu, učenje i poboljšanje provedenih istraživanja. Zbog povećanog interesa za radionicu, napravljena su i tri kratka izlaganja klasičnog formata kratke prezentacije (15 min.) i diskusije publike (5 min).

Radionica je uspješno privukla raznoliku publiku s 18 sudionika, s raznih instituta i sveučilišta poput Sveučilišta u: Bristolu, Budimpešti, Linzu, Lucernu, Iasi, Londonu, Manchesteru, Leibnizu, Zagrebu i Rijeci.
